His scope of responsibility included \$550 million in facilities and equipment, \$750 million in aircraft, \$120 million in operating budgets, and command of 2,000 personnel.

General Simpler received his commission from the United States Air Force Academy in May 1989 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Humanities. He then completed undergraduate pilot training at Reese Air Force Base, Lubbock, Texas, where he was named a Distinguished Graduate. He participated in military operations to include Operations PROVIDE COMFORT, NORTHERN WATCH and SOUTHERN WATCH. General Simpler joined the Florida Air National Guard in 1998 and held numerous positions at the 125th Fighter Wing. As wing commander, he was responsible for the Federal Air Sovereignty mission, the state mission of the unit and the geographically separated units. He was also Chairman of the Air National Guard Aerospace Control Alert Weapons System Council.
