

LIEUTENANT COLONEL KEVIN M. "PEEPS" PIEPER

Lt Col Kevin Pieper is Commander, 1st Air Force, Detachment 3, Patrick Space Force Base, Fla. Detachment 3 is tasked to provide War Department Human Space Flight Support to National Aeronautics and Space Administration Commercial Crew, Artemis, and Soyuz programs and is responsible for worldwide astronaut rescue, recover, and retrieval, medical operations, as well as nominal and contingency landing site support.

Lt Col Pieper entered the Air Force in May 2007 through ROTC from the University of North Dakota. He earned his pilot wings from Fort Rucker, Ala. And joined the Air Force's Combat Search and Rescue forces as HH-60G Pave Hawk pilot in January 2011. In his first three assignments to Kadena AB, Japan; Moody AFB, Ga.; and Kirtland AFB, N.M.; Lieutenant Colonel Pieper served as Chief of Scheduling, Executive Officer, Chief of Mobility, Flight Commander, Chief of Squadron Standardization and Evaluations, Deputy Chief of Group Standardization and Evaluations, Assistant Director of Operations, and Group Resource Advisor and flew as Copilot, Aircraft Commander, Flight Lead, Instructor Pilot, and Evaluator Pilot. Prior to his current assignment, he served as Requirements Branch Chief, Assessments Division, Joint Personnel Recovery Agency, Joint Staff J-7, Fort Belvoir, Va.



Lieutenant Colonel Pieper has deployed extensively conducting Casualty Evacuation and Combat Search and Rescue as Pilot, Aircraft Commander, and Flight Lead to Afghanistan in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM and FREEDOM SENTINEL as well as Squadron Director of Operations to Turkey in support of Operation INHERENT RESOLVE.
